Some of Our Current Funds (November 2015)

- **Benton Lake Watershed Conservancy Fund**
This fund was started with the intent to improve the water quality and usage at Benton Lake in Cologne, MN.
- **Carver County Veterans Memorial and Registry**
The Mission of this fund is to plan, build and maintain a Veterans Memorial and Registry which will be located in the city of Mayer, Minnesota.
- **Minnesota Association of Occupational Health Nurses Scholarship Fund**
This fund provides scholarships to students pursuing degrees in the field of occupational health.
- **Rick's 4F Foundation Fund**
The purpose of this fund is to provide grants addressing the needs of youth, seniors and the homeless.
- **St. Francis Heart Fund**
This fund was initiated by St. Francis Regional Medical Center as a mechanism for providing grants for AEDs.
